- ◆ The Gallery of Wearable Art (p. 62) celebrates its 20th anniversary with the birth of a new fragrance, created by owner/designer Bronni Kupris. Like the shop's one-of-a-kind fashions, each bottle of the fragrance is unique. Kupris has hand-selected beautiful antique perfume bottles, contemporary art glass and limited-edition bottles in which to package her Wearable Art scent.
- ◆ Further blurring the line between art and commerce, a new store/gallery, Work In Progress (p. 63), offers a mix of exclusive European and American designer fashions on its main floor, while local New York artists create and display their work on the lower level.
