This month, the dynamic divas thread their heads and play footsie.

Judi: My quest for the highbrow eyebrow leads me to Shobha, a serene and exotic oasis of hair removal that specializes in threading, a centuries-old, longer-lasting method of facial hair removal. With brows grown shaggy, I sit before threader extraordinaire Smita, who deftly ministers to my caterpillar-like bristles with what appears to be a spool of Coats & Clark. Mary: Hidden away in a cozy nook at the far end of Bergdorf Goodman's lower-level cosmetics department, BuffSpa is the place to go to transform your tootsies. Try the Barielle treatment, or gather some key

Barielle products to keep your feet petalsmooth between visits. Dry-exfoliate using the Titania Pumice Sponge (\$7), a two-inch powerhouse that can also be used daily in the shower. Follow that exfoliation with a sandy swipe of Barielle's Pedi-scrub Foot Smoother (\$19) and a warm slathering of Intensive Foot Cream (\$20), made with deep-sea mud. For a longer-lasting nail job, apply Barielle's Manicure Extender (\$16) after a few days, and, of course, apply foot cream and hand cream regularly.
