So when I tell you I put this little kit to the test....I really mean that I swore off a razor for two weeks just so my lovely readers could have the best review possible.;)

Pros:

- * At \$30, this kit is FAR cheaper then buying a wax pot and definitely cheaper then those regular professional waxing visits.
- · 'Sugaring IS less intense then waxing.
- . * The sugaring gel heats up fast and actually stays hot.
- * Kit comes with a talc-free powder to soak up excess oils on the areas that will be sugared.
- · * Clean-up was easy and mess-free.
- *Made of all natural ingredients which means all natural reactions...I had no irritation whatsoever after sugaring.
- . *It's easy to order more supplies online when you run out of a particular item.
- *Comes with two different sized reusable spatulas.
- . *The results last just as long as if you had used regular wax.

Cons:

- * I had to go over certain areas multiple times because the sugaring gel just wasn't as
 effective as wax when it came to stubborn/coarse hair.
- *The reusable denim strips were supposed to make the experience less painful because
 of the extra weight of the fabric. I'm not sure where they got this from. It felt just the same
 as when I used my disposable, muslin strips.
- "I simply don't have the time to wash these reusable denim strips and they had to be cut down smaller to do facial areas.
- I wished the kit would have included a post-sugaring product to remove any excess gel and to soothe skin.
