The signature treatment at the cheery **Dhaga Full Service Salon** (294 Fifth Ave., nr. 1st St.; 347-689-3827) is eyebrow threading (\$8). Technicians maintain the client's natural brow shape while creating clean arches. Walk-ins are accepted.

Stark Waxing Studio (425 W. 14th St., nr. Washington St.; 212-367-8200) aesthetician Lura Jones uses a French hard wax, which minimizes irritation and leaves brows stylishly shaped (\$35).

Book a year in advance for Eliza Petrescu's famed arch (\$128) at **Eliza's Eyes** (30 E. 76th St., at Madison Ave., fifth fl.; 212-757-0702), which she creates by waxing, shaping with tweezers, penciling in, and gel-setting.

BRONZE SKIN

Prince St., Ste. 501; 212-431-0077) offers thorough shade consultation to first-timers, who can expect sun-kissed, streak-free skin that lasts up to a week (\$60). Maria Bonita Salon & Spa (12 Prince St., nr. Elizabeth St.; 212-431-1520) is best known for its Brazilians (\$48), which are thorough, precise, and over in a few big swoops. Waxing is followed by the plucking of ingrown hairs and an application of soothing aloe vera.

Anjali Arora created the service menu at **Shobha** (594 Broadway, nr. Prince St., Ste. 403; 212-931-8363) and boasts more than 30 years of hair-ripping experience. Her Brazilians can be done via natural sugaring (\$100). House calls can also be arranged (\$250 per hour, with a two-hour minimum).
