Found in: Shampoos, conditioners, body washes, soaps, lotions, shaving creams, and depilatories.

Banned by: Canada and Japan.

Why it's controversial: These preservatives are common irritants and allergy triggers, and animal studies show they could damage cells in your nervous system, like your brain.
